The three cities are a piece of living history, being three of the oldest cities in Malta, and represent the best setting for this activity.

BEACH ACTIVITIES

SANDY BEACHES

With some of the clearest water in the Mediterranean, Malta's sandy beaches are a true godsend. Together with our students, we will discover the most picturesque beaches and enjoy both the crowded beaches of Golden Bay and Gnejna Bay, always full of locals and tourists, as well as the quieter, smaller, and more secluded beaches such as Ghajn Tuffieha and Paradise Bay where visitors have the chance to relax and become one with nature

ROCKY BEACHES

With plenty of rocky beaches forming the perimeter of the island, Malta has a beautiful spot for everyone. The activities on the Rocky Shores are focused not only on swimming and snorkelling in the beautiful azure water but also on explaining to the students how these peculiar shores were formed. It is worth mentioning that the rocks are flat making it ideal to sit on and relax, and that there are bars and shops close by. The rocky beaches hide another amazing side of Malta which is not to be missed!

FULL DAY EXCURSION

BEST OF MALTA NORTH

The north of Malta has a lot to offer providing the best sandy beaches on the island, a variety of water sports activities, boat rides, and amazing walks leading to some of the best views in Malta. Our students will be able to enjoy several historical and natural attractions including Popeye Village and the Red Tower. The itinerary of this day-long excursion is designed to offer the best experience that the North of Malta has to offer!

BEST OF MALTA SOUTH

Several of Malta's most extraordinary historical and natural sites lie in the less-visited southeast of the country. We visit Ghar Dalam cave, full of fossilized remains of prehistoric animals and the remains of a Bronze Age settlement. There's splendid coastal scenery, too, optional boat trips to visit grottoes, and fabulous swimming spots off the tourist trail. A must-see is also the fishing village of Marsaxlokk where our students can enjoy the scenery of the many colourful boats along the coastline
